


'ADA In 3D' available on the Apple App Store and the Android Market

ADA in 3D is an illustrated and interactive version of the 2010 Americans with Disabilities (ADA) Standards for Accessible Design. The 2010 standards became enforceable by the Department of Justice in 2012. Now you can see the standards in 3D pictures and models.
